



Magnetotelluric and temperature surveys consist of non-invasive surface measurements of the Earth's magnetic and electrical fields and shallow temperature field. Target depths of interest are usually greater than one mile. Surveys are necessary to locate deep sources for possible clean and renewable geothermal power development, protect existing hot springs, and conserve other water resources in the vicinity.
